FURTHER INFORMATION:

In addition to the completed short application form, applicants must provide and attach the following:

1. Verification of Vasa Lodge membership

The Recording Secretary of the Local Lodge in Pennsylvania District No. 9 -- in which qualifying membership is claimed -- needs to verify in writing on Local Lodge stationery -- that the applicant has been a member in good standing for at least two full years. Lodge membership must be achieved by January 1 of the prior year.

2. Essay:

Applicant must submit an essay – no longer than one page – on what he/she plans to do with the scholarship, either in attending Sjölundén, working at the Vasa Archives or, especially, if defining his/her own program.

If the applicant's proposal is to engage in study or a program either in the U.S., Sweden, or other Scandinavian destination, the District's Scholarship Committee must be provided with sufficient information on the program or institution and the specifics in order to consider the proposal fully.

3. Allowed Expenses

Expenses for the award of up to \$3,000 will be allowed for transportation, lodging and incidentals related to program participation (registration fees, etc.) . If a personal car is used for transportation to the venue, the District Lodge will pay mileage at \$0.35 per mile. Expenses will be paid as receipts are submitted.
