Please join us for our next regular meeting.

Firstly, as noted above, we will have a solemn remembrance of our dear member Gerry Schueman who sadly passed away on July 3, 2019. We will Drape the Charter in the celebration of Gerry. Members will be offered the opportunity to speak about their memory of Gerry.

Secondly, as part of our business meeting, we will discuss the current financial information for Drott Lodge. Our Treasurer Eva Dunhem has worked diligently the last few months to review in detail all financial records since 2016 to ensure that we have a complete understanding on the financials for our Lodge. She has been greatly aided by the QuickBooks bookkeeping software to enter all available financial information. Eva has been able to reconcile with all available bank statements to get accurate profit and loss statements and balance sheets.

Our auditors will also review the information prior to the meeting.

Members will receive by email prior to the meeting Profit-and-Loss statements and Balance Sheets for the period of January 1, 2018 – December 31, 2018 and for the period October 1, 2018 – September 30, 2019. Summaries of the financial results will be discussed for our two 2018 bazaar activities, our own bazaar and our participation at the SWEA/HoS bazaar. A proposed budget for year 2020 will be presented for review and approval by the Membership. The proposed budget will include proposed allocations among others for meeting and cultural activities, Special Goals donations and administrative expenses.

One thing becomes very clear: Our Lodge will financially not survive more than a few years without having our yearly Bazaar. It is what gives us the financial resources to do our activities and thrive as a Lodge. Our financial reserves will be depleted within few years without the Bazaar. So, please support by volunteering for our Bazaar in November and let us all strive to keep going with the Bazaar for many years to come.

We have been renting a storage unit 10'x10' in size in Rockville, MD for all our Lodge items including a lot of items for our Bazaar. However, the rent was just raised to \$300 per month. After significant work effort by some Members, we have been able to find and move to a different storage unit 10'x10', also in Rockville, MD. The rent is about \$134 per month plus \$16 per month in insurance. This results in a savings of about \$1,900 per year.

#### **MEMBERSHIP DUES**

Our Membership Chair Carol Whitley has over the last month sent numerous reminder letters with enclosed reply envelopes to Members that are overdue with their annual dues for 2019. Many of you have responded and submitted the dues payment. This is highly appreciated. If you have not yet paid your 2019 dues, please mail a check to Treasurer Eva Dunhem at Drott Lodge #168, 20640 Hope Spring Ter, #406, Ashburn VA 20147–2953. Dues for regular Members is \$50 per year. Dues for Youth Members and Drott Lodge Life Members in 2019 is \$25.75. Youth Members are those aged 14 to 24; Life Members are those who are 75 or older and who have been Members of the Lodge for 10 or more years. The reduced amount due begins in the year following the 75th birthday. Paid membership entitles a Member to a pass on the meal fees associated with the March Pea Soup dinner and the September Welcome Back Crayfish Party. However, those Members who pay only the minimum dues required (\$25.75) are expected to pay meal fees if they attend.

The reduced amount for Youth and Life Members is equal to the amount of the assessments the Lodge must pay out annually to the Grand and District Lodges for each Member. No part of this reduced amount is retained by Drott Lodge.

Many Lodge Members choose to pay the full amount of the annual dues even if in "Life Member" status. Others add an extra amount to the required minimum dues to help support the Lodge.

With all due respect, and in truth and unity, we hope to hear from each of you who have not paid yet.

#### STORAGE

Members of Drott Lodge during the week of September 16th, 2019 relocated all its stored items from a storage facility in Rockville, MD to a new storage facility on Parklawn Drive, Rockville, MD. This relocation will result in a cost reduction of about \$1,900 per year. We installed a new metal shelf system to permit the storage of a number of plastic boxes and containers for items that we use or sell during our Bazaar. It will also be used to store a number of boxes with historical files about Drott Lodge. Christmas and Midsommar celebration related items that belong to American Scandinavian Association (ASA) are also stored at the new facility for which ASA compensates us.
