We will meet on Sunday May 21 at 2 PM for a business meeting, including draping of the charter in honor of members who have passed away.

### It Came to Me on a Whim

How can good people commit horrendous crimes? Maria Bouroncle's book *It Came to Me on a Whim* tells the story of a deeply hidden family secret. The book was published in English in 2022 and is currently used in the Scandinavian Crime Literature course at UCLA.

Our May program features Maria Bouroncle, a Swedish author who set about to answer that question. Bouroncle was originally an economist by profession who spent over 25 years in the field of international development before publishing her first novel in 2018. *It Came to Me on a Whim: The Story of Ingeborg Andersson, Child Murderess* tells the story of Maria's great aunt, who killed her three children in 1929. Her riveting real-life story has been translated into several languages.

Maria was born in 1965 in Gothenburg, but she has lived in Washington, DC

since 2002. After the success of her first book, Maria decided to follow her passion and pursue writing professionally. In 2022, the independent sequel, *The Girl with a Name Tag: A Finnish War Child in Sweden,* was published in Swedish.

In 2021 and 2022, Carl Eneroth's film "The Child Murderess of Vesene," based on Maria's book about Ingeborg, won the prize for Best Short Documentary in Budapest, London, Miami and New Jersey. The documentary will take us to unsettling locations, including the murder scene, the courthouse where Ingeborg was sentenced, and the cemetery where her children are buried. Relatives tell the chilling story of Ingeborg and her family.

We are fortunate to have Maria as our guest speaker. She will tell us a bit about her genealogical research and how she discovered the story of her great aunt, and then we will view the 16-minute documentary.



### A view from the side - until August 27, 2023


Lars Tunbjörk (1956 – 2015) is one of Sweden's most internationally renowned photographers. His photos display warmth and humor and a deep fascination with feelings of loneliness and the longing for meaning. His images encourage the viewer to pause and think, and they evoke a range of emotions, including happiness, recognition, sadness, and anger. Tunbjörk had his big breakthrough in 1993 with "Landet utom sig," his photo project about Sweden that received the most attention over the years. Following his sudden passing in 2015, the Tunbjörk Foundation was established to preserve the entirety of Tunbjörk's body of work.
